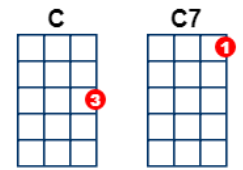


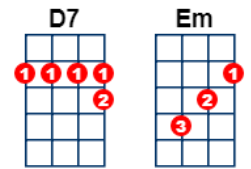
At The Hop

[C] Bah-bah-bah-bah, [D7] bah-bah-bah-bah at the [G] hop!

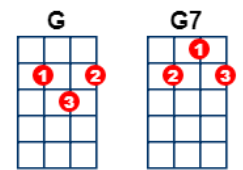


Well, you [G] can rock it, you can roll it,
