[C] We'll have lots of [F] fun with mister [C] snowman

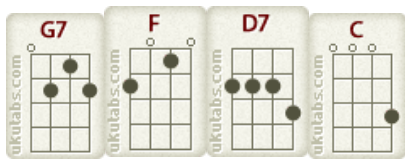
